

**Marine Service Center Winterization Options**

**PRICES DO NOT INCLUDE TRANSPORT OF VESSEL TO OR FROM SHOP**

---

***Engine Winterization - \$285.50 + tax per Engine***

The engine(s) are run on an antifreeze machine to clear the block of straight water. Fuel stabilizer is added to the fuel, and a fogging chemical is added to the engine. The batteries are then disconnected unless required for engine hatch operation. Engine oil will be checked and adjusted accordingly. For Dry Storage Vessels, the bilge plug will be removed and attached to steering wheel. For water based winterization engines are drained and filled with antifreeze.

---

***Drive Service - \$380 + tax per Drive***

Requires the vessel be hauled to the Marine Service Center - Haul/Launch fees vary by boat. Includes pulling the drive(s), changing gear lube, grease u-joints & gimbal bearings, clean & refill monitor bottle, verify engine alignment. Inspect bellows and anodes. Top fluid levels & grease fittings. Make any needed recommendations.

***House Systems Winterization - \$140 an hour 1 hour min***

We drain fresh and lake water systems, as well as air conditioning systems. Compressed air is blown through the lines. Can be done in conjunction with other options or can be done on its own.

---

***Generator Winterization - \$150 + tax***

Non-toxic antifreeze is run through generator. Engine is fogged & battery is disconnected.

***\*\*\*Winterization is void once vessel is operated, removed from moorage, or water tanks are filled. Winterizations completed after air temperature falls below 32 degrees Fahrenheit may be requested and completed by the Marine Service Centers, but the work is not guaranteed to prevent the vessel systems from damage from freezing.***
